Reflection for the 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time (from Today's Liturgy, published by OCP)

Today's Gospel story is about Martha and Mary. It is complementary to last week's story, the parable of the Good Samaritan stresses care of neighbor, while today's Gospel emphasizes the importance of a relationship with Jesus by listening to his Word, and devotion to him.

Today's readings are straightforward. Hospitality requires both service and presence. In our liturgical ministries, the difference between an usher and a minister of hospitality is that of presence. When managing the worship space, the usher is not asked to be present to the people he/she serves. The usher who also goes outside the doors of the church to help those who arrive in wheelchairs, offers both service, and presence in the model of Jesus. This is very different than hospitality minister who are at the church entrance, greeting parishioners and handing out bulletins to all who enter.

The true minister of music does not sing a song for the assembly, but studies thoroughly the word of God and prays the word of God in song. The Eucharistic minister shares, not gives the Eucharist to people.

Lectors must know what they are talking about. It takes more than a "once over" to proclaim the Word of God. Otherwise, we are distracted, not drawn into the reading, or song, or prayers.
