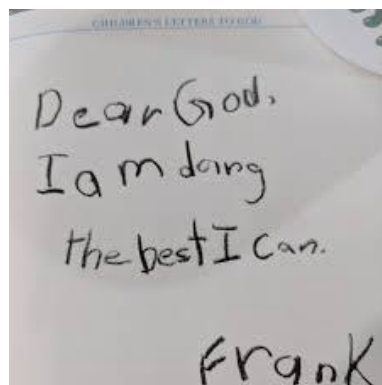

**Mass at Calvary Cemetery** will be held next **Sunday, August 4**, beginning at **3 pm**. All are welcome. Please note that the Mass will be held under a canvas canopy, away from the elements. Remember to **bring your own lawn chair and water.** Portable **washroom facilities will be available on site.** Calvary Cemetery is located off Houlton Street, with the driveway leading to the cemetery near the former Canada Bread facility and the Woodstock Rural Cemetery entrances.

### Shrine Sunday 2019

The **96<sup>th</sup> Annual Pilgrimage to St. Francis of Assisi Shrine** at Upper Skiff Lake takes place on Aug. 11<sup>th</sup> with the Most Reverend Robert Harris, Bishop of Saint John Diocese, as principal celebrant. The chapel will be open for prayer at 10 am with open air mass at 11 am.

Afternoon services begin with the Holy Rosary at 1 pm in the three founding languages – French, English and Maliseet, This is followed by the Sacrament of Healing at 2 pm. All are welcome to join in this Spiritual Journey.

A canteen will be operating in the kiosk at lunchtime. **Bring a lawn chair.** Come and enjoy the day.

The Shrine, which received its heritage designation in 1999, sits on a portage trail at Upper Skiff Lake. The small church at Skiff Lake, which is home to the Shrine, was built in 1865 by local settlers from farms in the area. The pilgrimage tradition began in 1923 and The First Nations people attended. Today their descendants continue to come.

Ample parking is available, with disabled parking next to the church. Bring your chair, come early to experience the day, meet old friends and make new ones. Everyone is welcome to join the choir or volunteer to help with the services.

To reach the site, take exit 212 at Meductic, Turn onto Route 122 towards Canterbury. You can take Mill Street to Upper Skiff Lake Road – follow the signs. Or drive on Route 122 to just past Skiff Lake, turn right onto the Upper Skiff Lake Road – follow the signs.
